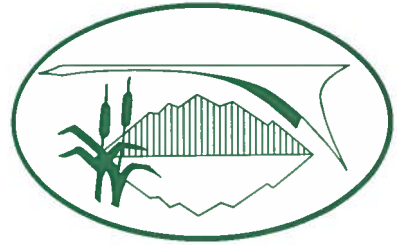

RE: Old Kootenay Channel Site Restoration Project 2012 - Seismic 2000 Construction Ltd.

To who it may concern,

Seismic 2000 Construction Ltd and its employees recently (September 2012) completed rehabilitation work on the bridge spanning a small section of the Creston Valley Wildlife Management Area (CVWMA) wetland and the Old Kootenay Channel, west of Creston, BC. The CVWMA is an internationally recognized wetland - Ramsar Site - as well as an Important Bird Area in Canada (IBA), and it provides vital and sensitive habitat to hundreds of wildlife species, some of them at risk.

While the rehabilitation project on the Old Kootenay Channel Bridge presented some environmental risks to the surrounding habitat (wetland and channel) and to the species occupying it, Seismic 2000 employees worked diligently to minimize negative impacts on the habitat and wildlife species. Two minor incidents occurred during the duration of the project and they were reported and dealt with readily by Seismic 2000 staff.

Seismic 2000 staff kept the work site safe and clean throughout the duration of the project and demobilization was done very well; the site was left in excellent conditions.
